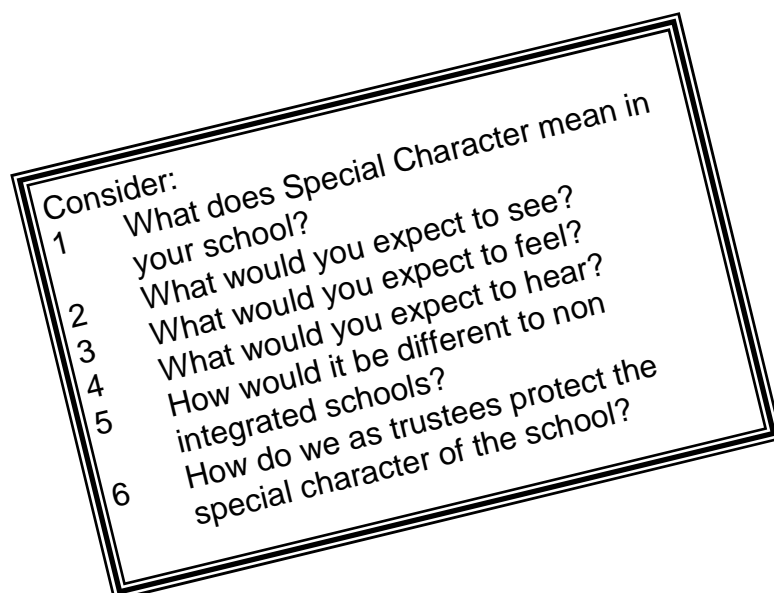


Policy: Special Character

- Assist *Catholic* parents in passing on their faith and values, recognising that parents are the first teachers, and their homes the first College of their children
- Have *Catholic* principles central to policy decisions
- Have *Catholic* principles put into practice in the day to day operation of the College
- Encourage students to live by the values of Jesus Christ
- Encourage staff and board to see that each has a role to play in promoting the Special Character of the College
- Encourage staff and board members to reflect in their own behaviour an appreciation of the fact that they are involved in a College promoting *Catholic* values
- Ensure that the major feasts of the *Catholic Church's* liturgical year and selected feasts significant to the Marist tradition of the College are celebrated fittingly as an expression of the *College's* commitment to its Special Character.
